SUMMARY:

Policy drafts were shared with the members for review prior to the meeting. Approximately 20 policies reviewed. The remaining policies to be reviewed in the January workgroup meeting -

100. LE Authority
Result of HB 4301 update; cleans up some language and added ORS
200. Organizational Structure and Responsibility
Minor updates in 200.3.1, 3.2 and 3.3. Updated wording without change to policy such as CERC (no longer exists) to current SOC (Security Operations Center)
206. Emergency Ops Plan
Updated with specific unit title for reporting inclement weather
216. Staffing levels
Cleaned up some language making it more relevant to the updates within the department. Two personnel to be on duty
221. Retired Peace Officer CCW Endorsements
New UOPD policy. This has been a federal law for a few years but new to UOPD based on federal statute
300. Use of Force

Change came in this morning from Lexipol. Capt. Riley sent to the group for review to address immediately; the next work group meeting will not be for another six (6) weeks.

Lexipol added an ORS along with a few other changes primarily defining and clarifying.

Policy 300.3.6 has gone from an *alternative*, to *should*, to a *shall*

309. TASER Conducted Energy Weapon

Minor change to 309.6 Documentation

311. Officer Involved Shooting and Deaths

Minor updates; UOPD specific title changes to 4.2 and 5.3

313. Firearms

Minor language clean up with the Glock 19 being added to the listing for on duty uniformed officers

315. Vehicle Pursuits

315.2.1 Lexipol recommended language cleanup for best practice. Discussion occurred surrounding this policy as it is a big change for officers. The captains all plan to visit all shift briefings to answer questions and provide clarification if desired. Recommended that with new policy, new trainings should follow –

“Willfully/willful” – Captain Riley will be looking into alternative wording with Lexipol

318. Medical Transports and Services

Removed MedExpress as a named service; the university did not contract with them as originally discussed

327. Adult Abuse (combo)

327.3 reworded per Oregon senate bill 1540. Current Language and recommendation were both sent for viewing and comparison to the work group; hence the combo. State Statute and OAA encouraged the update

335. Amber Alerts

Few title updates reflecting current UOPD staff titles

347. Media Relations

Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFR) – addition due to federal law requiring policy addressing flight restrictions over crime scenes

352. Outside Agency Assists

Title IX language added; group believes this is disclaimer is helpful also

357/465 combo

Dropping 357 Civil Disturbances and Demonstration; adding 465 First Amendment Assemblies. Both policies were sent to the work group for comparison and discussion

358. Major Incident Notification

Removing CERC which no longer exists within UOPD.
Notification path updated to Crisis Emergency Notification System Policy

359. Clery Act

UOPD will follow S&RS notification policy. Policy is found on the S&RS website.
Few other minor corrections to language

360. Death investigations

Person/title change for notification and 2.3 has been reworded

382. Service Animals

2.1 updated to include other animals

391. Rape Aggression Defense (RAD) System Program

All agency content, no change, updating release date from 2017

393. Native American Graves Protection

New policy, meets federal law requirements. Recommended to us for implementing
